COLD WEATHER DISMISSAL PROCEDURE DURING INTERSESSION

Our school day ends at 3:45pm each day during the regular semester. Students who are not attending another after school activity (Office Hours, detention, athletics, etc.) will be asked to leave the building by 4:00pm each day. Students will not be allowed to wait indoors for a ride. PHONE POLICY
